**Detailed Description of Grant Proposal**

A statue entitled Onward and Upward Heavenly Doves will be built and installed on the center of the marble slab and will be visible from the church eastern window.

The statue is designed to create a focal point and to enhance the landscape and create a noteworthy place of remembrance. It is anticipated that this will become more of the special place that Rose Diestler and the other Columbarium Committee envisioned.

The statue will be approximately 16 by 54 inches in size consisting of a double helix with 12 to 14 doves
